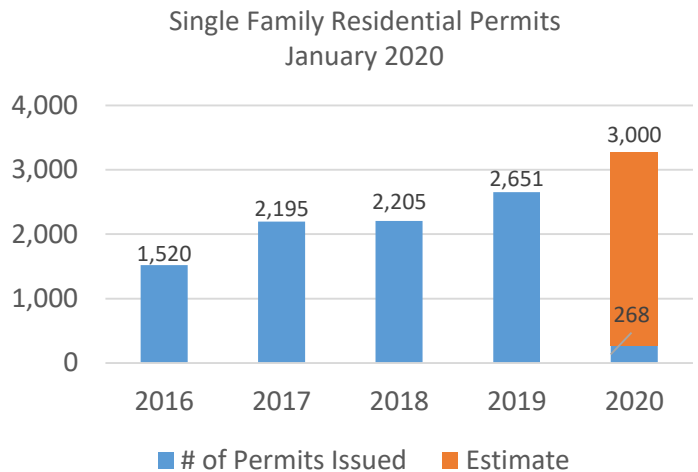

## Annual Residential Permits

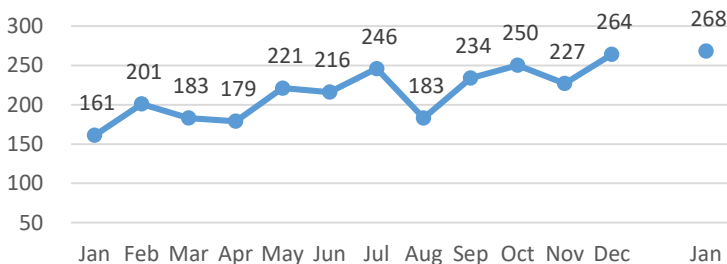
Since 2016, Buckeye has issued over 8,500 SFR housing permits and ended 2019 issuing 2,651. With 2019 being such a successful year, the city estimates continuing on this trajectory and is projecting upwards of **3,000 SRF permits in 2020**. With an average of just over 3.2 persons per unit, the city anticipates an increase in population by another **9,600 residents** in 2020.

With **35 residential developments** currently active in Buckeye, we anticipate over 21,000 residential lots developed over the next 5 years. These active developments are anywhere from the pre-application stage, preliminary and final plats, to actively constructing new homes.
